McKeesport Housing Corporation

McKeesport Housing Corporation (MHC) was created 24 years ago to provide financial assistance to low/moderate income homeowners in the city of McKeesport. The goal was to provide Home Improvement Loan Program funds for the upkeep of the housing stock within the City. The decline of the steel industry, along with the departure of related supporting businesses, resulted in many area homeowners relying on low paying jobs. McKeesport also realized an increase of retired elderly on fixed incomes.

Since its inception in 1985, MHC,, through its many programs, has facilitated home repairs and renovation to over 700 homes throughout the City of McKeesport. Over the past three years alone, MHC has administered owner-occupied rehab projects for the City totaling \$883,370.00. On average, 17 low/moderate income families per year received home repairs they otherwise could not afford.

MHC is also a Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO). Over the years, MHC has collaborated with many partners in our homeownership programs. These partnerships, which include state and local government agencies, no-profits, community and private sector organizations, have assisted MHC in facilitating homeownership for 47 low/moderate income families. In all, 33 new single family homes were constructed and 14 existing homes were rehabbed and sold to qualified buyers. In addition, MHC was the developer of Grandview Apartments, a 26 unit building for elderly residents constructed on the former Grandview School site in McKeesport.
